## Program Fee Waivers

Members in good standing who are experiencing financial hardships may have fees pertaining to AFS educational programming waived, either fully or partially. To be eligible, members must fulfill the following:

1. The Member, their parent(s) or guardian(s), or representative thereof, must request the waiver.
2. The Member must show a willingness and commitment to learning to play the fiddle, as well as a willingness and commitment to fully participate in the program under consideration.
3. Reference(s) reflecting the affable/sociable nature (ie, team spirit) of the Member may be provided by teachers, music instructors, councillors, coaches, or any other prominent member of the community.

Requests to waive fees are reviewed and granted on a per case basis, and have no impact on subsequent requests. This policy applies solely to the waiving of registration fees, and does not carry any monetary or otherwise transferable value. AFS assumes any and all other expenses relevant to AFS programs are incurred by the Member.

AFS provides programs, including its fiddle rental program, at discounted or subsidized rates and, as such, is under no obligation to provide further subsidies, grants or fee waivers for any reason.
